Pre-entries must be in or postmarked by July 26, 2024

DRESSAGE CLASSES: Dressage rides will be limited to **50** entries. Excess entries will be returned based on postmark day. USDF rules will be followed. All tests are the most current year available. No sharing of horses allowed for the same test. **Readers are allowed.**

JUMPING CLASSES: Are allowed to cross enter up to 1 class either above or below. Ex. Cross rail class can enter into the 2' class, but not 2'3. 2'6 class may enter 2'3 class, but not the 2' class. Same for the Jumpers. Horses are allowed to be shared for any equitation class, but not the hunter classes within the same division. Horses may be shared in jumper divisions.

HANDY HUNTER CLASSES: is a versatile hunter class. It must have at least two changes of direction and at least three of the following: a combination, hand gallop a jump, a bending line, a rollback turn, a fence at the end of the ring, or a trot over one jump. Judging a horse is based on brilliance of pace without sacrificing performance or style.

COURSE A VS. COURSE B

"A" classes will have a different jump course than "B" classes. Riders are eligible to enter both A and B classes.

CLOSING OF CLASSES: Jumping entries on the day of show will close 2 classes prior to class being entered; entries for classes 1-3 will close at 7:45AM.

CLEANING FEE: A cleaning fee will be assessed for every horse's stall or trailer tied. ***It must be paid with a SEPARATE CHECK. No cash.*** Stall and trailer spot cleaning checks will be torn up after stalls or trailer spots are checked.

LIMITED STALLS AVAILABLE: Stalls will be assigned on a first-come, first-serve basis. *No overnight stabling or camping.* **BRING YOUR OWN SHAVINGS.**

NO REFUNDS: **Fees are non-refundable without a vet letter. Office fee is non-refundable in all cases.**
